



SUMMARY OF STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

Children's/ AISD Student Health Services commits to providing safe care for students during school hours in collaboration with AISD school staff. The unique and nationally recognized collaboration between Seton Healthcare Family and Austin ISD has been in place since 1996. Registered Nurses lead the campus health team, which includes School Health Assistants and AISD staff. The Medical Director serves as a consultant with Student Health Services to develop procedures and services promoting health, wellness, and safety. Services are provided for student's ages 3 to 22 years of age and include:

Illness and Injury Care

- Minor injury and illness care, emergencies, and referrals
- Chronic health conditions
- Mental and emotional health conditions

Medication Administration

- Medication administration during the school day, documentation and reconciliation
- Training of AISD staff to administer medication

Immunization Compliance

- Monthly identification of students needing immunizations
- Immunization clinics

- Referral to community services
- Parent notification

State Mandated Screenings

- Hearing
- Risk Assessment for Type 2 Diabetes
- Vision
- Spinal

Case Management

- Allergy/Anaphylaxis
- Diabetes

- Asthma
- Seizure
- Other chronic health conditions and pilot programs

Health Education

- Student/Individual or group (hand washing, growth and development, nutrition)
- Parent
- AISD Staff (Bloodborne pathogens, AED, MRSA, Heat related illness)
