## It's The Law!

Effective **September 1, 2009**,  
Texas requires all children  
under age 8, unless they are  
4'9" tall, to ride in a car seat  
or booster seat.

A booster seat is used for  
children who have  
outgrown their "car seats"  
but are too small for adult  
seat belts.

Boosters help protect kids  
by keeping the seat belt  
on the strongest part of  
the child's body.
