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## COVID-19 Vaccine and Vaccine Administration Procedure Codes

### Background:

On November 10, 2020, the American Medical Association (AMA) announced new procedure codes for the COVID-19 vaccines and vaccine administration. On December 11, 2020, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued Emergency Use Authorization for the use of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine.

### Key Details:

On December 11, 2020, in accordance with the FDA's issuance of Emergency Use Authorization for the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, vaccine administration procedure codes 0001A and 0002A are benefits for Texas Medicaid for individuals 16 years of age and older. Vaccine procedure code 91300 is informational only while the vaccine is distributed to providers free of charge.

Providers should reference the table below when submitting claims for vaccine administration:

| Vaccine Code | Vaccine Administration Codes | Labeler Name | Administration Interval |

| 91300        | 0001A (first dose)           | Pfizer       | 21 days                 |
