

All MCOs: COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Code M0201 Now a Benefit

Key Details:

Effective for dates of service on or after June 8, 2021, COVID-19 vaccine administration add-on procedure code M0201 is now a benefit of Medicaid. Procedure code M0201 is an add-on procedure code for use when a COVID-19 vaccine is administered in the home setting and is the only service provided in the same home on the same date. Procedure code M0201 must be billed with one other COVID-19 vaccine administration code (0001A, 0002A, 0003A, 0011A, 0012A, 0013A, or 0031A).

Procedure code M0201 is a benefit for Medicaid for the following providers and places of service:

Place of Service	Provider Type
Home	Physician, Physician Assistant (PA), Nurse Practitioner (NP), Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS), Clinic/Group Practice, Home Health Agency, CCP Provider

Providers may bill MCOs retroactively for COVID-19 vaccine administration add-on procedure code for the home setting provided on or after June 8, 2021. MCOs must reprocess affected claims submitted with the procedure code and date of service on or after June 8, 2021. Providers are not required to appeal the claims unless they are denied for additional reasons after the claims reprocessing is complete.

Action:

MCOs must reimburse providers for the COVID-19 vaccine administration as outlined above.

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
