

AIM Specialty Health® lung cancer screening prior authorization guideline update

Effective for dates of service on and after January 28, 2022, AIM Specialty Health* will follow the Texas Medicaid prior authorization guideline and criteria outlined in the *Texas Medicaid Provider Procedures Manual* for lung cancer screening. The details can be found in the *Lung Cancer Screening* section of the *Inpatient and Outpatient Hospital Services Handbook* at tmhp.com/resources/provider-manuals/tmppm.
